

SWPBS – School Wide Positive Behaviour Support SWPBS stands for School-Wide Positive Behaviour Supports. It is a framework that focuses on prevention through the creation of a school culture that is positive, safe, predictable and consistent.

The approach emphasizes teaching student's behaviours we expect to see, providing reminders when needed, and acknowledging expected behaviours. Behaviour Matrix are displayed around our school and classrooms. Students are rewarded with tokens when they display desired behaviours and follow school rules. A weekly focus is taught in all classrooms.

We encourage students and their families to leave the car at home on this day and get a taste of the benefits involved in choosing to walk or wheel to school.
