#### From the Principals desk...

#### Child Safe Standards

There have been a number of changes to the Child Safe Standards requirements for schools. This has included changes to polices. School Council will be discussing these policies tonight. The policies will then be sent to all parents via Skool Loop to allow you the opportunity to provide feedback.

The policies under review include, Child Safety Code of Conduct, Child Safety Responding and Reporting Obligations Policy and Procedures, Complaints Policy (students and parents), Volunteers Policy, Yard Duty and Supervision Policy, Digital Learning Policy, Visitors Policy, Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy, Bullying Prevention Policy and the Child Safety Policy.

#### Little Learners Love Literacy (LLLL)

Last Friday we hosted Little Learners Love Literacy Day 2 training. Six of our staff, were joined with 16 staff from three local schools. The training allowed us to increase our knowledge of the importance of explicit and sequential teaching of phonemic awareness skills and phonics. LLLL has been running in the F-2 area this term and we have already seen the positive impact it is having on our students learning. LLLL further enhances our current teaching programs.
